2 Graphite Pencils - grade H & 2H (Staedtler Mars Lumograph)

2 Erasers - Pentel 'Clic'  
Kneaded Rubber

Drawing Pad - Strathmore Bristol Vellum 300 series  
9" x 12" – pad of 20 sheets

Divider - A measuring tool, similar to a compass but with 2  
points (no adjusting wheel!)

Whisk - Desk broom to sweep eraser crumbs

Magnifying glass

Gooseneck table lamp
